Dear Parent/Guardian/Student,

Please forgive the late hour of this letter, but I have just had news from the authorities with information about the secondary students returning to school.

Due to the current health situation in Abu Dhabi, it has been decided that Years 7, 8, 9 & 10 will remain with Distance Learning until further notice. I understand that this will be received with disappointment by you, but please understand that such decisions are made in the best interest of the health and safety for our children.

Examination Years of 11, 12 & 13 will have an option of returning this Sunday 27th September, or to remain with Distance Learning.

Those students that opt to return to school, must have a negative Covid test before entering the school. In the next 24 hours Mr Abass, the Head of Secondary, will be in touch with you to explain this process, where you will be given a code to take to the testing centre. Students can only be readmitted into school if the test is conducted through entering our school code. 'Private' tests will not be valid. Mr Abass will also outline the strict protocol that we have for these students coming back to school. We are awaiting this code which will be shared with you as soon as possible.
