Back in November, 42 of our current Year 11 students sat an early entry iGCSE in English as a First Language exam.

Today, I am delighted to report that 93% of these students passed with an A*-C grade.

Alongside these fantastic results, I am delighted to announce the achievements of the following students who sat 3 early entry exams:

Samaa Ahmed gained an A* in Biology; A* in Chemistry and an A in English Language .

Menna Hassan gained an A* in Chemistry; B in English Language, and a B grade in Maths.

In addition, two other brave students sat 2 early entry exams gaining the following results:

Elliot Graham-Sommerville gained an A in English Language and an A in Maths.

James Thomas gained a B in English Language and a C in Chemistry.

Despite having no physical school for 10 months prior to these exams, and sitting the exams a year before the course is actually completed, these grades are testimony to the students hard work and dedication, alongside the huge effort, quality of ongoing provision, and support of their teachers during this pandemic.

In addition to these results, I am also very proud to announce that we have had our TIMSS (Trends in Maths & Science Study) scores sent to the school, where we have entered the top Advanced Tier in the world for Secondary Science. These tests are conducted in the school (pre-covid) and compared with schools around the world.

As always, I am extremely proud of all of our students and staff who continually work hard to achieve the very best, now and in the future.
