- COURTESY: Fellow students, teachers, those in supporting roles, office, catering, cleaning and maintenance staff are all equally important to the school and deserve your respect . Good manners are expected at all times.
- CONSIDERATION: Behave towards others as you hope they would behave towards you. Whatever you do, think first how you would feel if it happened to you.
- COMMON SENSE: A few written rules are necessary to any community, but for the most part, common sense will tell you whether something is right or not. BE SENSIBLE
- RESPECT: ● Respect for oneself: (appearance; organisation; commitment) ● Respect for others: (pupils; teaching staff; non-teaching staff and visitors ● Respect for the environment: (classrooms; changing rooms and lavatories; stairwells; grounds and other places visited)
