Year 6 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 2nd September 2024

This week, we will be continuing with our initial topic - **'Who am I?'** as we to get to know the children in our classes better and help them establish their daily routines including moving to their specialist lessons.

In maths, we will begin our place value learning to gain a deeper understanding of numbers up to ten million. In English, we will be using our reading skills and recapping our sentence and punctuation knowledge. In English writing we will start focusing on our first fiction topic of the year. We will be doing suspense writing and looking at the features that makes a successful piece of writing in this genre.

In Art we will focus on drawing self portraits. This activity will lead into pop art which is a topic that all students enjoy learning about.
