#### Week beginning: Monday 9th September 2024

Maths	We will be finding 1000 more or less than a given number. Following on from this we will be rounding numbers up or down to the nearest 10, 100 or 1000.
English	We will be introducing our new model text and using many adjectives to describe characters.
Science	We will be investigating living things, to explore and compare different characteristics.
Integrated Curriculum	We will be starting our topic called Al Ain Defenders. The children will be exploring the Emirates, before comparing Dubai and Al Ain.
