Year 6 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 9th September 2024

Maths	This week in maths, we are excited to begin our first unit: Place Value. In this unit, we will dive deep into numbers up to ten million, exploring their structure and significance. Our focus will also be on comparing and ordering these large numbers.
English	This week in English we will start to read our Zelda Claw text. We will be exploring different word classes and new vocabulary. Year 6 students will be using Talk For Writing to understand their new model text and how this relates to our English focus this half term of 'suspense writing'.
Science	This week in science we are excited to start our first unit on 'Classification of Animals', learning about the characteristics of vertebrates and invertebrates.
Integrated Curriculum	This week in IC we will start our topic, Building to the future. We will research and investigate how we think the world will change over the next fifty years. During our second lesson we will work with maps to identify the UAE's position in the world.










