Year 6 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 16th September 2024

Maths	This week we will be learning to compare and order numbers. We will also be reviewing rounding of numbers. Lastly, we will be learning about negative numbers and using them in context e.g temperature.
English	This week, we will use appropriate language to describe our senses. We will act out our model text, Zelda Claw, through drama. In the second part of the week we will focus on writing and drawing our own text map and also look at different features of an effective setting description.
Science	In science this week we will be investigating the work of Carl Linnaeus in creating the classification system and organizing a branching classification key to sort living things according to observable characteristics.
Integrated Curriculum	This week in IC we will be investigating the meaning of latitude and longitude. We will then apply our knowledge and skills during map work to identify a range of locations. During this lesson we will be using an atlas to write down the coordinates for specific places.
