Year 4 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 9th September 2024

Maths	We will be ordering numbers up to 1000 and beyond. This learning will lead onto comparing numbers up to and beyond 1000. The children will be building on their knowledge of 3 digit numbers to be able to solve problems with 4 digit numbers.
English	We will be learning to use fronted adverbials, with a focus on time, place and manner. The children will be learning how to add these into sentences and use them with a comma. We will continue to learn our text with actions.
Science	We will be investigating the characteristics of different groups of animals and will be interpreting different classification keys to identify animals.
Integrated Curriculum	We will be investigating why settlements are built and why the settlement locations were chosen.
