## Year 2 learning:

### Week beginning: Monday 30th September 2024

Maths	In maths, the children will begin learning about 'Addition and Subtraction'. This week, the children will work on their addition and subtraction skills with a focus on calculations totalling 20 or less. Alongside this, they will learn that addition of numbers can be done in any order but the order of numbers in a subtraction calculation cannot be changed. Following this, the children will develop their investigative skills by comparing related addition facts and discussing what patterns they notice. For example: 7 + 2 = 9 and 70 + 20 = 90.
English	This week, the children will plan and innovate the story of 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch'. They will use their imagination to change parts of the story and then use their plan to begin writing the opening and the build-up to their version of the story. The children will continue to develop their independent writing skills by making sure that sentences are punctuated correctly and include adjectives.  We would like to request that each child bring in a book of their choice to read each day.
Science	In science, the children will begin the unit 'Animals including Humans'. This week, they will investigate how animals and humans have offspring which grow into adults. Within the lesson, the children will also get to observe real-life examples of adults and their offspring from the 'GrowZone'.
Integrated Curriculum	In topic, the children will continue to learn about the lives of significant people. This week, the children will focus on the lives of both Neil Armstrong and Florence Nightingale.
