Week beginning: Monday 30th September 2024

Maths	We will be reviewing mental maths strategies, along with addition and subtraction methods. We will be applying and using this learning as we solve written maths problems.
English	We will be developing our story writing skills, by using a 'Boxing Up' technique as build our story plan. We will use our story plans to write and act our stories. We will edit our stories as the final phase of our writing.
Science	We will be identifying parts of flowers and discussing their relative functions. In the laboratory, we will be dissecting flowers and labelling the various parts.
Integrated Curriculum	We will be learning about the concept of sustainability through group discussion and work. This will introduce to the topic of renewables through reducing, reusing and recycling within the UAE.
