## Year 2 learning:

#### Week beginning: Monday 7th October 2024

Maths	In maths, the children will continue to learn about 'Addition and Subtraction'. This week, they will consolidate their knowledge of comparing related addition facts, such as: 7 + 2 = 9 and 70 + 20 = 90. Following this, they will use their number bonds to 10 knowledge and apply it to finding number bonds to 100. For example, 3 + 7 = 10 so 30 + 70 = 100. Next, the children will learn to add and subtract ones. This will involve first learning to add and subtract 1 from a 2-digit number before moving onto adding and subtracting 1-digit numbers from a 2-digit number (without crossing the 10). For example: 23 + 1 and 23 - 1 before moving onto 23 + 4 or 27 - 6. The children will also be encouraged to notice patterns within this lesson. At the end of the week, the children will complete a short hot task so that we can assess their understanding of what they have been taught so far.	
English	In English, the children will write the remaining sections of their innovated story, which is inspired by 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch'. They will continue to develop their independent writing skills by making sure that sentences are punctuated correctly and include adjectives. We will also encourage the children to edit and improve their work using a purple pen.  We would like to request that each child bring in a book of their choice to read each day.	
Science	In science, the children will learn about how animals and humans have offspring which grow into adults, with a focus on life cycles. When learning about the human life cycle, they will use words, such as: baby, toddler, child, teenager and adult.	
Integrated Curriculum	Our 'Hero Dress Up Day' is on Friday (11th October). On this day, the children are invited to come into school dressed up as one of their heroes. For inspiration, some of the heroes that we have been learning about in class include: doctors, fire firefighters, police officers, scientists, astronauts, superheroes and Sheikh Zayed. Furthermore, in art, the children will create their own 'Pop Art' artwork using pastels.
