# Year 3 learning:

#### Week beginning: Monday 7th October 2024

Maths	In maths we will be beginning to learn how to add and subtract ones, tens and hundreds from a 2 and 3 digit number. The children will explore using a number line, manipulatives and the column method to support calculating the answers.	
English	The children will be learning how to plan their own story based on the Green ship, changing the characters and setting. They will then write their own version using their plan and our success criteria, which is to include adjectives, punctuation, similes, prepositions and noun phrases. We will be teaching the children how to edit and improve their work and there will be opportunities to share their stories with the class.	
Science	To start the week off we will be learning about the different muscles in our body and why we need them. Then we will return to our enquiry question 'What is nutrition and why is it important in animals including humans?' and answer it using what we have learnt so far. To finish off our topic, we will complete the hot task to assess what we have learnt.	
Integrated Curriculum	We are continuing with food technology this week. The children will be visiting the kitchen to make their own sandwich using their design and method. Then learning how to evaluate what they have made.
