## Year 5 learning:

#### Week beginning: Monday 7th October 2024

Maths	In maths, we will be moving onto subtraction after spending a week on addition. The children will be subtracting 4 and 5 digit numbers with an exchange. They will also be able to deepen their thinking by solving word problems involving these topics. The children will then be using the inverse operation to solve missing word problems.
English	The children have worked very hard innovating our model text this week. Next week, the children are going to be inventing their own newspaper report using all the writing features we have learnt. We can't wait to see what they produce!
Science	As we come to the end of the half term, the children will be finishing their Science learning of properties and changes of materials. They will have to opportunity to display everything they have learnt.
Integrated Curriculum	In topic, the children are going to be working collaboratively to create their very own presentations about an Emirate in the UAE. They will be looking at geographical features, tourist attractions and more.

- Speak appropriately when communicating with others




