Year 2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 21st October 2024

In maths, the children are continuing to develop their addition and subtraction skills. They will begin the week by practising to double numbers up to 10 + 10. We will encourage them to identify patterns before recalling these number facts and applying them to problem solving tasks. Next, the children will learn to add three 1-digit numbers. They will be shown how to use different strategies, such as: doubles and number bonds. The children will then learn how to 'add to the next 10'. For example, 28 + = 30. They will use practical equipment, such as: dienes, bead strings, number lines and tens frames, as well as their knowledge of number bonds to 10. At the end of the week, the children will complete a cold task so that we can understand their prior knowledge of the objectives that are coming up this half term.
In English, the children will be surprised with a letter from the Worry Monster telling them all about his half term holiday. The children will then plan and write their own letter back where they will tell the Worry Monster all about their half term break. Following this, the children will complete a hot task, which will involve planning and writing the opening to their own losing tale independently. The focus will continue to be on making sure that their sentences are punctuated correctly and include adjectives.
In science, the children will start learning about 'Living Things and their Habitats'. They will begin the unit by comparing the differences between things that are living, dead and things that have never been alive.
To launch our new topic, 'What a Wonderful World', we would like each child to bring in a clue about where in the world they are from on Monday 21st October . This could be a small souvenir, a photograph, a small piece of artwork, a piece of clothing, local coins/currency or anything else that you think is suitable. However, please ensure it is something small and not anything too valuable. These items will be kept safely in school throughout the week and returned to the children to bring home again on Friday 25th October. In art, the children will discuss the work of a range of artists, including Monet and Van Gogh.


