## Year 3 learning:

#### Week beginning: Monday 21st October 2024

Maths	In Maths we will be continuing with addition and subtraction and learning how to use the column method to add a 2 digit number to a 1 digit number, and then a 2 digit number to a 2 digit number. Towards the end of the week we will answer questions that require regrouping. For example 135 + 27.
English	Our new English focus is going to be on a non fiction text about Al Ain Zoo. We will be exploring persuasive adverts and what makes a good advert. The children will be learning about alliterations this week and how these can be used in adverts.
Science	Our topic this half term is Plants. We will be investigating plants and identifying the different parts and functions of a plant. The children will have the opportunities this half term to visit the grow zone and grow their own plant.
Integrated Curriculum	Our new topic is called An Oasis in the Desert. We will be exploring what an Oasis is and learning about Al Ain. Firstly locating Al Ain and the other emirates on a map and finally, learning how to draw an Oasis.
