## Year 5 learning:

#### Week beginning: Monday 21st October 2024

Maths	As we start the new half term, we will be revising our understanding of addition and subtraction. We will also be learning 1 step problem solving questions involving these concepts.
English	We will be starting a new text this week called Theseus and the Minotaur. We will take part in some role play activities before writing our own. After this, we will analyse a myth, looking at the different features needed to create one.
Science	In science, we will be learning about magnets and forces. In lesson 1, the children will be explaining magnetic forces. In lesson 2, the children will be identifying magnetic and non-magnetic materials in our daily life.
Integrated Curriculum	In Topic, we will be starting our new learning of the Romans. We will be looking at the impact it had on the world. First, we will look at the purpose of a museum before looking at the Roman inventions.
