### Year 1 learning:

### Week beginning: Monday 28th October 2024

This week, we will continue with our talk for writing text and learn about non - chronological reports. We will start the week by recapping our knowledge of the features of a non - chronological report. We will then sort facts into categories and add our own actions to help learn the text. We will then begin to write our own report about camels after

In maths, we will begin the topic of subtraction and start by learning what the subtraction sign looks like and how we complete a subtraction math sum. We will learn how to use a number of strategies to complete our subtractions such as practically with manipulatives,

In phonics, we will learn our split digraphs, u-e as in June, u-e as in tune and ar as in car. We will be learning to identify, form and read words using these, as well as challenging ourselves to write the sounds in words and sentences.

In science we will be learning about materials and will start the week by looking at a range of everyday materials and if we can identify them in objects around the classroom. We will then use this knowledge in D&T to investigate which materials will be the best when making our own construction.


