



Year 3 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 28th October 2024

Maths	The children will be learning how to add 3 digit numbers using the column method, where regrouping is required. We will also start learning how to subtract using the column method (where no exchanging is needed).
English	This week the children will be learning new vocabulary and what these words mean. We will be exploring different punctuation like question marks and exclamation marks and when to use these in our writing. The class will be discussing the different features of a persuasive advert and learning what these are - alliteration, boastful language, appealing adjectives, exaggeration and rhetorical questions.
Science	This week we will begin to plan our investigation 'What do plants need to survive?' and 'What is the most important thing needed for a plant to survive?' The children will begin their investigation, visiting the Grow Zone to observe and grow a plant.
Integrated Curriculum	In Art the children will be studying the UAE National flower, sketching it and using watercolours to present the beauty of the flower. We will also be learning about the history of Al Ain and creating a timeline of the development.
