Year 4 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 28th October 2024

Maths	We will be extending and strengthening our knowledge of the x3 and x6, x4 and x8 timetables. We will be comparing number sequences and multiples of those numbers, to find patterns.
English	We will be building our writing skills by examining paragraphs. Through comparing paragraphs in different contexts, we will understand how paragraphs help organize a text.
Science	We will be learning about the journey of food through the human digestive system. This will include the functions and vocabulary of the internal organs involved.
Integrated Curriculum	We will continue our study of the UAE, including the important buildings within Abu Dhabi. We will focus on the transport systems within the UAE and how bridges assist with the traffic flows.

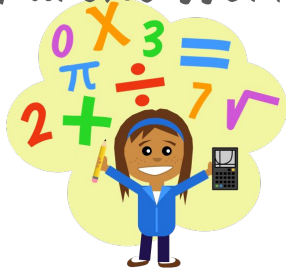
