Year 5 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 28th October 2024

Maths	Next week in maths, we will be multiplying 2 & 3 digit numbers by 1 digit numbers. First we will be looking at factors & multiples. Then, we will be using this to multiply using the short multiplication method.
English	In English, we will be developing our oracy skills by having a go at role-playing different types of myths. We will also be learning word classes used in our model text before analysing the characters by describing them. Additionally, we will be using synonyms in our work.
Science	As we continue our science learning next week, we will be defining conductors and insulators before having a go at classifying materials as conductors and insulators.
Integrated Curriculum	We will continue or Roman learning next week. We will be learning about what the Romans have done for us before ranking them in a diamond 9 to decide which was the most and least important thing they left us and why. After this, we will be locating countries that were invaded by the Romans.
