Year 6 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 28th October 2024

Maths	In our maths lessons, we will start division. We will start by focusing on short division to ensure a solid understanding, and as we improve, we will gradually tackle long division to build our skills further.
English	Writing - This week in writing we will be identifying features within our model text 'Delve Into Dubai', creating our own success criteria relating to the theme of persuasion, clarifying new vocabulary and learning how to use exciting synonyms within our persuasion skills.
Science	This week in science we will be investigating and identifying how animals have adapted to suit their environment. We will be comparing animals from different biomes e.g. desert tundra vs ice tundra.
Integrated Curriculum	In our Integrated Curriculum lessons, we will be investigating the location of the countries that we find in Europe. During our second lesson, we will apply prior knowledge and skills to use an atlas successfully. We will develop our skills and strategies in how to use an atlas.

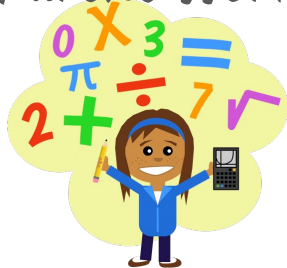



Tolerance

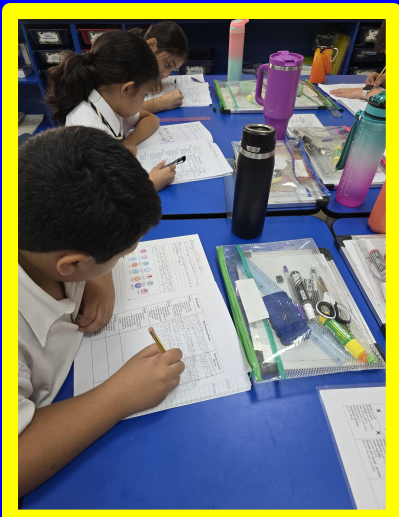
Inspired by the legacy of the founding father, Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan we will focus on the value of **Tolerance** this term.

- Understand and support each other if mistakes are made

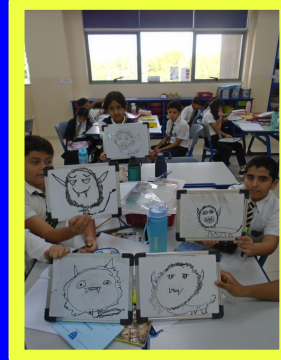
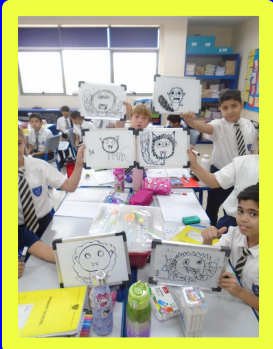
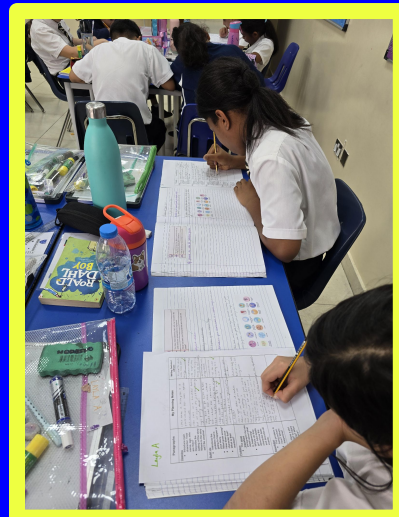


This week in pictures:
