

#### Celebrating Student Success





#### Asperger Syndrome Level 1 (ASD)



Asperger's is a neurodiversity need, on the mild end of the autism spectrum. Individuals with Asperger's are noted to be generally higher functioning than regular autism. Although, an individual with Asperger's my experience significant needs in the three main areas like Autism (social interaction and communication, information processing and understanding and sensory processing and integration) they usually have normal, or above normal intelligence.

#### **Strategies**

Establish regular routines and structure (provide warnings before transitions and with changes, clear expectations and boundaries)

Provide opportunities to develop and support social skills, interaction and extended learning

Connect using their special interest (e.g. if they like trains use this to engage them, as a positive reward, or a source of discussion etc.)

Incorporate lots of visuals such as timetables, checklists for completing tasks etc. as well as verbal instructions
