Preschool learning:

Week beginning: Monday 11th November 2024

This week in Phonics, we will keep exploring a range of exciting sounds that we can create using our bodies. As a group, we will listen to an upbeat song and brainstorm various body sounds that we can replicate in a pattern for our peers to mimic, all while maintaining the rhythm

This week in literacy, we will start creating a story map to help us retell the tale of 'Supertato.' We will collaborate to brainstorm the most appropriate actions that represent the various sections of the story. In drawing club, we examine some unfamiliar words more closely and illustrate their meanings.

This week in math, we will further enhance our subitising skills using transportation and small world figures. We will take a virtual bus ride around Al Ain, assisting the small figures as they get on and off at various stops, while using our subitising skills to recognise how many people are on or off the bus.

This week in Understanding the World, we will observe and reflect on the growth of our planted seeds. We'll take photos to assist us in recognising the changes that occur over time and identify the different parts of the plant while using sequencing cards as visual aids. We will also use our bodies to demonstrate each stage of the plant life cycle, from seed to fully grown plant.

This week in Expressive Art and Design, we will continue our exploration of colour mixing using various mediums and our hands. We'll introduce an additional colour to discover what new shades we can create with this simple adjustment.
