Year 1 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 11th November 2024

This week, we will continue with our talk for writing text and learning about non - chronological reports. We will start the week by recapping our knowledge of the features of a non - chronological report. We will then relook at our notes from this week and edit these to complete our own report all about ourselves.

In maths, we will continue the topic of shape and will be learning all about 2D shapes. We will identify and name common 2D shapes such as circle, triangle, square. We will discuss some of their features and show our understanding of 2D shape by identifying and sorting them.

In phonics, we will learn our digraphs, ea as in bread, ur as in fur and then complete an assessment on our learning so far. We will be learning to identify, form and read words using these, as well as challenging ourselves to write the sounds in words and sentences.

In science we will be learning more about materials and will explore the uses of everyday materials. We will recap our previous learning by identifying and naming different materials that we can see in these objects.
