Year 2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 11th November 2024

Maths	In maths, the children will revisit some areas of their learning that we would like to consolidate. This will include number bonds to 20 using different representations, such as a bar model and subtracting a 1-digit number from a 2-digit number. Following this, they will learn how to add two 2-digit numbers using pictorial representations of dienes to support. They will also learn how to subtract one 2-digit number from another using different methods, such as a tens frame and pictures of dienes.
English	In English, the children will continue to practise orally retelling the Worry Monster's letter. The children will revisit how to use question marks correctly and use this skill to write questions. They will then learn all about how and when to use exclamation marks accurately. Furthermore, the children will use and apply their knowledge of punctuation (full stops, question marks and exclamation marks) to properly demarcate sentences.
Science	In science, the children will continue to learn about the unit 'Living Things and their Habitats' by deepening their understanding of how animals obtain their food.
Integrated Curriculum	In Integrated Curriculum, the children will learn about the difference between geographical human and physical features. In art, they will learn how to use clear and specific feedback to evaluate each other's landscape sketches.
