Year 3 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 11th November 2024

Maths	In maths we are moving onto our 'Measuring' topic. The children will be learning how to use a ruler correctly to measure in 'cm' and 'mm'. We will then be learning how to compare lengths and solve real life word problems.
English	This week we are going to start boxing up our persuasive advert for Al Ain Zoo. We will begin to plan and write up the first 3 paragraphs using what we have learnt about adverts in our writing (boastful language, alliterations, appealing adjectives and rhetorical questions).
Science	In science we will be continuing to observe and record our findings on our plant investigation. We will be measuring and recording how much our plants have grown so far. We will then learn about water transportation and complete a task using water, water colouring and a real plant to observe the transportation process.
Integrated Curriculum	The children will be learning how the country discovered oil and how we use oil today. We will be exploring how the over consumption of oil is impacting the UAE and what could this lead to in the future.
