Year 4 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 11th November 2024

Maths	The children will be deepening their understanding of multiplication and will be learning to multiply 3 numbers together. The children will then be solving word problems involving multiplication and learning different methods they can use to solve them.
English	The children will be gathering more information about Sultan Al Neyadi. They will be exploring a variety of sentence starters before they start to plan their paragraphs for his biography. They will then finish the week by completing the biography.
Science	The children will be learning about different types of foods animals eat and the teeth that different animals have to help them eat their diet. The children will also be learning and exploring the terms carnivore, herbivore and omnivore and what these mean.
Integrated Curriculum	The children will be investigating a variety of bridges from around the world. They will then be researching information about these bridges to produce a leaflet.
