Year 5 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 11th November 2024

Maths	After looking at multiplication last week, this week we will be moving onto division this week. The children will be doing short division of 3-digits by 1-digits and 4-digits by 1-digits. They will also be learning to divide with remainders.
English	In writing, we will be learning to use fronted adverbials accurately, analyse setting descriptions and create our own setting descriptions. Children will be reminded how to use commas and expanded noun phrases accurately.
Science	This week, the children will predict the most effective materials for different uses. They will then be setting up a fair and comparative test to investigate materials for making a fort.
Integrated Curriculum	We will be continuing our learning of Romans this week by looking at the Roman clothes and what they were used for. They will also be learning about Roman artefacts.

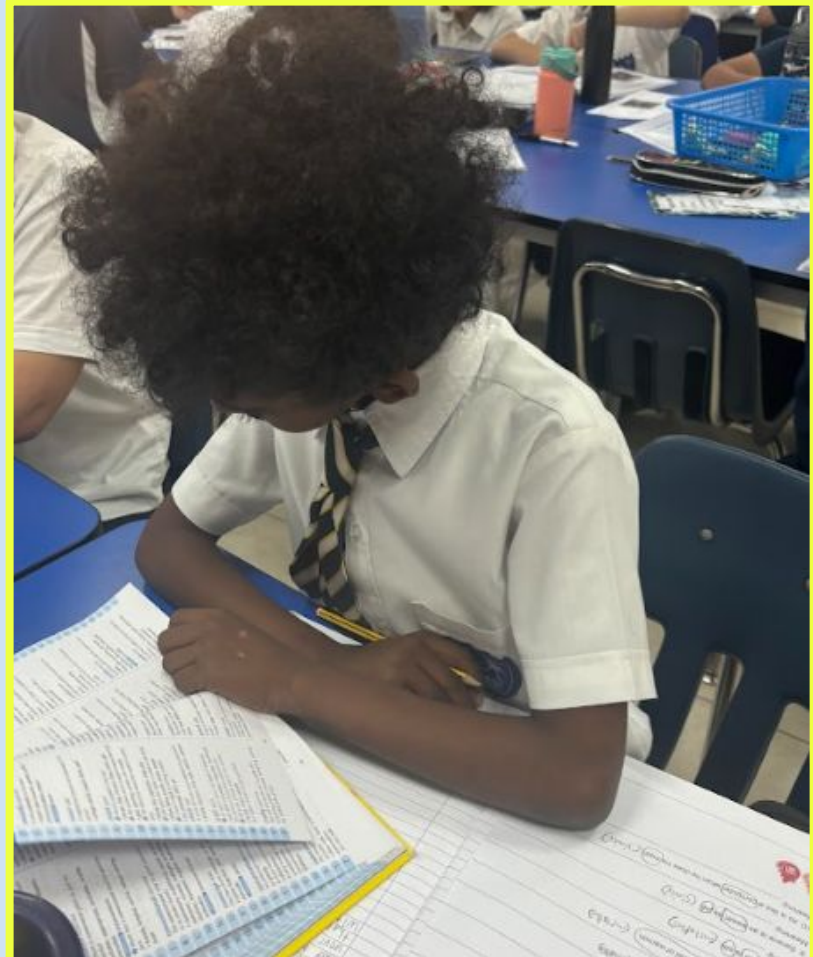
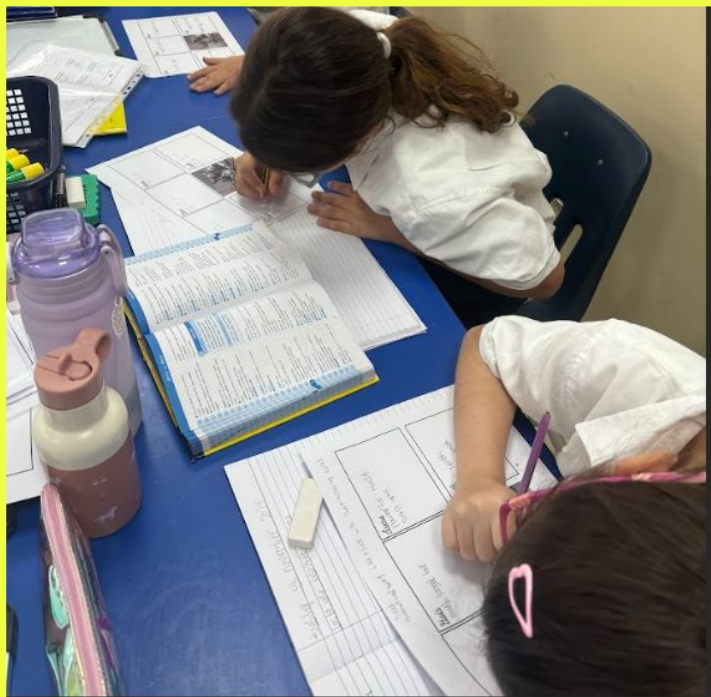


This week's photos
