Year 6 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 11th November 2024

Maths	In maths, we will find factors and multiples to see how numbers are connected. Then we will learn about prime numbers. Finally, we will use the order of operations to help solve Maths problems in the right order.
English	Writing - In English Writing, we will continue identifying figurative language within lyrics, show our understanding of our model text 'Delve Into Dubai' by using our drama skills, create a text map for our model text and we will also be defining and using hyperboles. Reading - Year 6 will continue reading Street Child in class focusing on vocabulary skills to elevated their understanding.
Science	This week in Science we will be exploring and investigating the adaptation of different plants and their habitats. We will focus on how they have adapted to thrive and stay alive.
Integrated Curriculum	This week in Integrated Curriculum, we will research, using different resources, in finding comprehensive information related to the human and physical characteristics of a country. During our second lesson we will use a variety of resources to find differences between Finland and the UAE.

Inspired by the legacy of the founding father, Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan we will focus on the value of **Tolerance** this term.

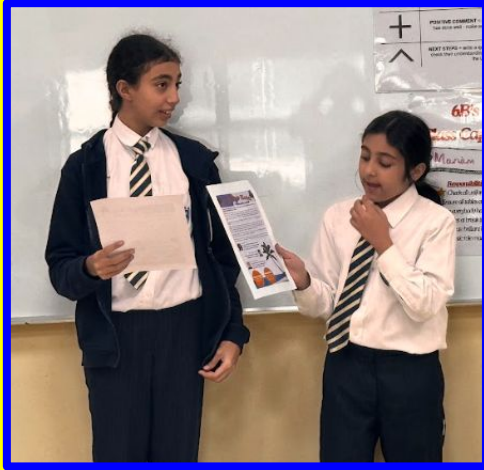
Our expectations are that students will:
