Year 2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 2nd December 2024

| Maths | In maths, the children will begin our 'Shape' unit of learning. They will start the week by naming 2D shapes (including quadrilaterals, pentagons, hexagons, heptagons and octagons) before learning how to accurately count the sides of different shapes. Next, the children will learn that vertices are where 2 sides meet (corners) and how to count the vertices of various 2D shapes correctly. They will also investigate and identify lines of (vertical) symmetry on different 2D shapes before sorting 2D shapes according to different criteria. |

| English | In English, the children will continue to plan and write a letter about our 'What a Wonderful World Day' last week. The children will be expected to include the following features: past tense verbs, conjunctions ('and', 'but' and 'so') and different punctuation (such as full stops, question marks and exclamation marks). We would like to request that each child bring in a book of their choice to read each day. |
| Science | In science, the children will continue to investigate 'Living Things and their Habitats'. Our next lesson will enable the children to understand that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited. |
| Integrated Curriculum | In Integrated Curriculum, the children will be using world maps, atlases and globes to identify the UAE and other countries in the GCC. |
