## Year 3 learning:

#### Week beginning: Monday 2nd December 2024

Maths	In maths we are moving on to 'Statistics'. The children will be learning how to read and present data through tables, pictograms and bar charts. They will be collecting data and drawing their own pictograms to show the results they have collected. Towards the end of the week there will be an assessment on everything taught this half term.
English	In English we are going to be learning how to use our advert plan to write up our own persuasive advert independently. The children have chosen an attraction and will be encouraged to include boastful language, appealing adjectives, alliteration, rhetorical questions and exaggeration to make their advert appeal to its audience.
Science	In science we will be learning about the fascinating plant life cycle. They will explore how a plant begins as a seed, then germinates and grows into a seedling. Children will discover how plants use sunlight, water, and air to help them grow, and learn about the importance of flowers in producing seeds for new plants.
Integrated Curriculum	In topic this week we will be looking at the future of the UAE and predicting what it might be like to live in the UAE in the future.
