



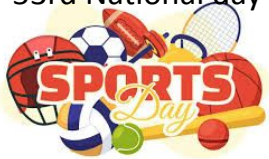

Week beginning: Monday 2nd December 2024

Maths	This week, we will deepen our understanding of fractions by exploring how to convert improper fractions into mixed numbers and vice versa. These skills will help to recognise and work with fractions in different forms.
