Preschool learning:

Week beginning: Monday 9th December 2024

This week in phonics, we will explore some simple rhyming pictures to enhance our awareness of words that rhyme and develop our understanding of rhyme. By engaging with these visual aids, we will not only learn to identify rhyming pairs but also enjoy playful activities that reinforce our phonetic skills and creativity.

This week in math, we will explore a variety of free-flow activities set up around Preschool that will assist us in connecting numerals to quantities while also enhancing our number recognition and counting skills. Additionally, these hands-on experiences will encourage teamwork and collaboration as we learn together in a fun and interactive environment.

This week in literacy, we will continue to identify words that start with the same initial sound by discussing our favorite stories from home or school. We will also explore how these stories connect to the sounds we hear, enhancing our understanding of phonetics and storytelling.

This week in Understanding the World, we will be transferring the seedlings we've been nurturing into our Preschool garden planters. We'll also revisit exploring the various parts of a plant, its life cycle, and share our eco-friendly ideas for keeping birds away and protecting our plants from being eaten.

This week in Expressive Art and Design, we will partner with a friend to select our building materials and use our imaginations to create a collaborative small world that we can showcase to our peers. We may even incorporate some of our favorite superheroes into our designs, adding an exciting twist to our imaginative play. This activity will not only foster creativity but also strengthen our communication skills as we work together on our project.
