Year 2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 9th December 2024

Maths	In maths, the children will continue to investigate 'Shape'. They will start the week by recognising the names of different 3D shapes (including cubes, cuboids, spheres, cones and pyramids) and comparing them to real-life objects. Following this, the children will focus on identifying the properties of different 3D shapes. This includes how many faces, edges and vertices each 3D shape has. The children will then move onto sorting various 3D shapes according to different criteria.
English	In English, the children will continue to plan and write their letter about our 'What a Wonderful World Day'. They will be expected to include the following features: past tense verbs, conjunctions ('and', 'but' and 'so') and different punctuation (such as full stops, question marks and exclamation marks). Following this, the children will publish their letter onto 'special paper' using their neatest handwriting. We would like to request that each child bring in a book of their choice to read each day.
Science	In science, the children will continue to investigate 'Living Things and their Habitats'. Our next lesson will enable the children to understand that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited.
Integrated Curriculum	In art, the children will use all of the skills that they have learnt in our art lessons this half term to produce their own landscape sketch. Following this, they will also paint their sketch using water colours.
