Year 3 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 9th December 2024

Maths	In maths we will be continuing to learn how to read data and present it in a variety of different ways. The children will be creating their own class data and presenting it using pictograms. The children will be challenged to use 'Keys' where the picture represents more than 1.
English	This week we will be focusing on using a range of punctuation. The children will be learning how to use commas correctly when writing a list, as well as when to use capital letters, question marks and exclamation marks.
Science	In science this week we will be completing our end of unit assessment, which will assess the children on their knowledge of our plants topic. We will finish the topic off by answering our enquiry question, "What is the most important thing a plant needs to survive?" consolidating what we have learnt this half term.
Integrated Curriculum	To finish off our topic we are continuing to look at the future of the UAE. The children will be presenting to the class a poster they have made inviting people to visit the UAE and all its attractions. The children will be encouraged to use what they have learnt about persuasive adverts to make their poster stand out.
