## Year 6 learning:

**Week beginning: Monday 9th December 2024**

<b>Maths</b>	This week in maths, we will compare and order fractions, practise adding and subtracting them, and finish with a maths assessment to consolidate our learning.

# Tolerance

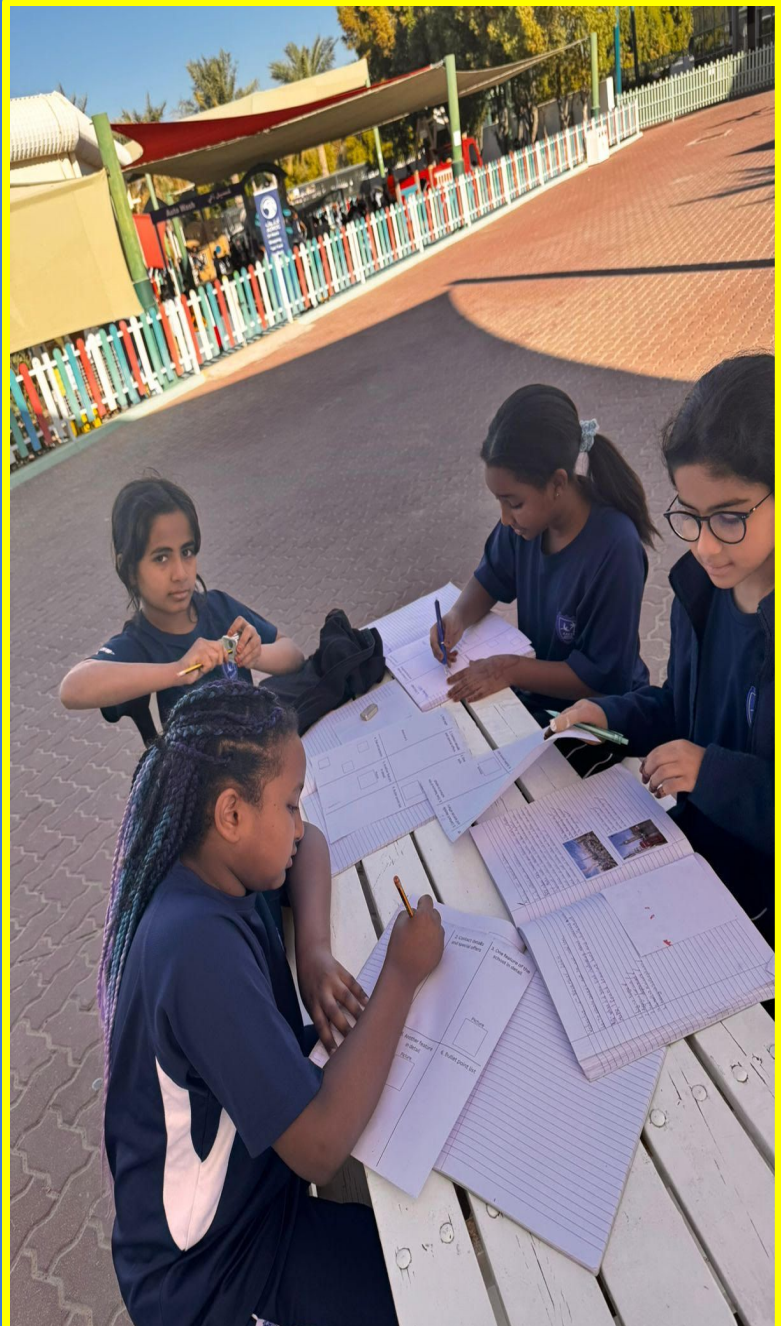
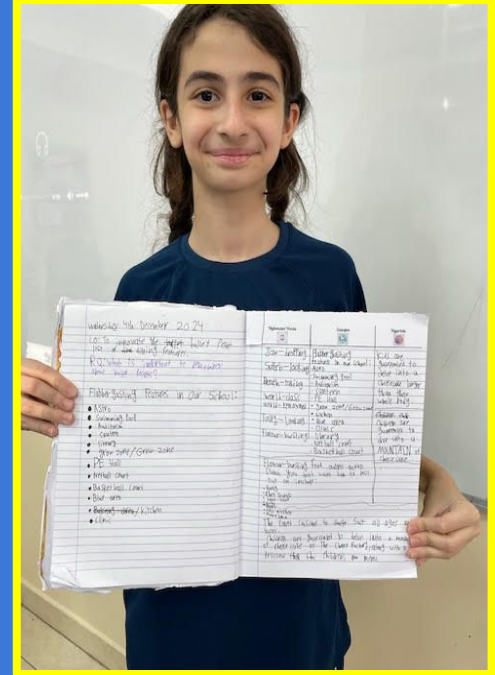
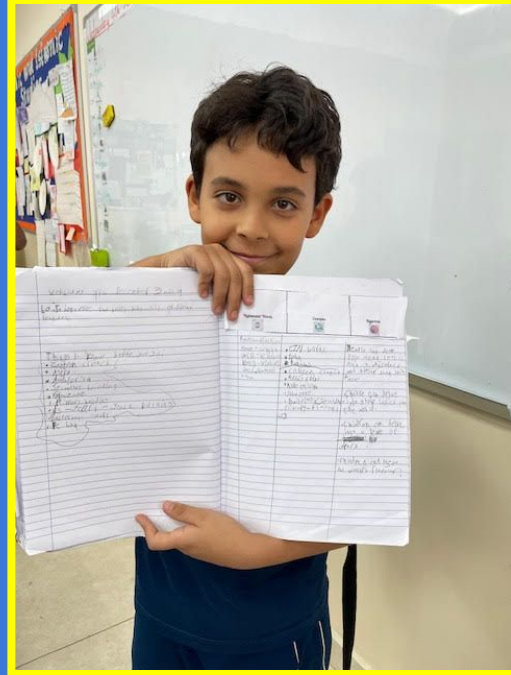
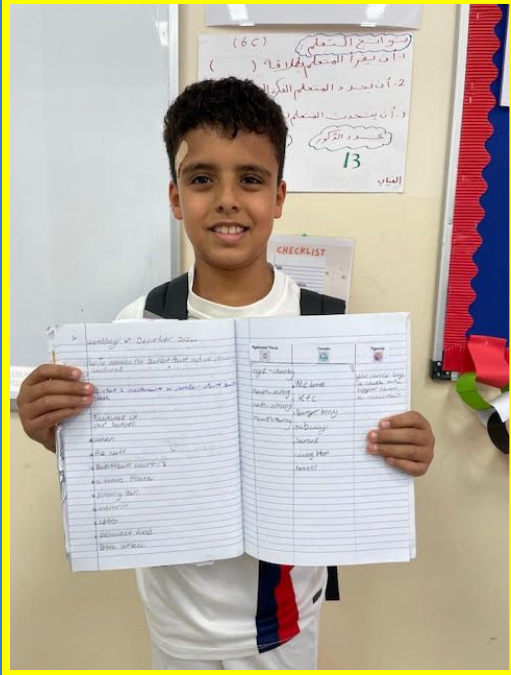
Inspired by the legacy of the founding father, Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan we will focus on the value of **Tolerance** this term.
