Year 1 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 6th January

This week, we will begin our Meerkat Mail text during our Talk 4 Writing lesson. We will start with a visit from Sunny the meerkat and will look at some clues from his postcards to discuss the places he may visit.

In maths, we will revisit our addition skill and will complete additions by counting on. We will then use our knowledge of number and addition to complete our number bonds to 20 and understand how this links to number bonds to 10.

In phonics, we will learn the digraphs ue (oo) as in blue, ue (you) as in statue and ew (oo) as in grew. We will identify, read and write words using these sounds, as well as challenging ourselves to write simple sentences.

In Science, we will begin our topic about animals and will learn how to sort them into groups such as mammals, reptiles, birds, insects, fish and amphibians.
