Year 2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 6th January 2025

Maths	In maths, we will revisit the children's knowledge and understanding of 'Addition and Subtraction', with a focus on finding ten more and ten less than a given number before moving onto adding and subtracting multiples of 10 (for example, adding 20 or subtracting 30) from a given number. Following this, we will be focusing on adding two 2-digit numbers (without crossing 10). For example: 24 + 35. The children will be encouraged to use practical equipment (dienes) and to 'draw out' the dienes (sticks and dots) in order to find the answer.
English	In English, the children will plan and write a letter about their winter break. They will be expected to include the following features: past tense verbs, conjunctions ('and', 'but' and 'so') and different punctuation (such as full stops, question marks and exclamation marks).
Science	In science, the children will begin learning about 'Plants'. First, the children will make a prediction about the best conditions for a plant. Following this, they will set up their own plant experiment, which they will observe the progress of over the coming weeks.
Integrated Curriculum	To launch our new 'Once Upon a Time' topic, the children will become 'time travellers' and they will learn like a UAE child from the past. In order to give the lessons an even more authentic feel, we would love the children to come into school wearing traditional Emirati clothing on Wednesday 8th January 2025 .
