Year 3 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 6th January 2025

Maths	In maths the children will be learning how to multiply and divide by 3s and 4s. We will be revisiting the short multiplication method and dividing using partitioning. For example 36 divided by 3. We will do 6 divided by 3 and then 30 divided by 3, finally adding the two answers together.
English	The children will start our next topic by hunting around the classroom for clues to what we will be learning about. We will introduce our new book 'Stone Age Boy' and predict where the story may have been set, who the characters are and what might happen. The children will learn why we use speech in stories and how to use inverted commas to show someone is talking, we will also learn what a verb and adverb is.
Science	This half term our topic will be Rocks and Fossils. In week 1 the children will explore how rocks are formed and will learn about the different types of rocks.
Integrated Curriculum	Our new topic is The Stone Age. The children will be hooked into our new topic in a creative way. They will be making spears, woolly mammoths, campfires and designing stone age outfits and using these to act out what it would have been like to have been alive during the Stone Age.
