Year 5 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 6th January 2025

Maths	In maths, the children will be learning to read and write decimals. They will be adding and subtracting within 1, adding and subtracting across 1 and then solving word problems involving decimals.
English	In English, the children will be introduced to their new text for the term. They will be reading through it and unpicking any unfamiliar vocabulary. They will also learn about organisational devices such as, headings, subheadings and bullet points. Lastly, they will be learning about modal verbs and how to use them accurately.
Science	For our new science topic next term, the children will be learning about forces. Firstly, we will be explaining falling objects using gravity. Then, we will be learning what friction is and its effects.
Integrated Curriculum	We have exciting things to learn in topic next term! We will be starting the term learning about Japanese earthquake drills and then learning how earthquakes are created.
