Maths	In maths, the children will continue to learn about addition. They will start the week by adding 2-digit numbers (not across a ten). For example: 23 + 34 = 57. The children will add the ones first, 3 + 4 = 7, and then add the tens, 20 + 30 = 50. They will also use visual representations, such as dienes, to support and deepen their understanding. Following this, the children will learn strategies for adding 2-digit numbers (across a 10), which will involve 'exchanging'. In order to secure their understanding of place value, they will learn to use the 'steps to success' and method below:		
	Steps to Success: 1. Identify the numbers 2. Count the ones 3. Exchange 10 ones 4. Recount the ones 5. Count the tens		
English	In English, the children will begin to learn about traditional tales. First, they will carry out a cold task where they will retell a familiar traditional tale. Following this, we would like the children to come into school with a teddy/cuddly toy, a pillow and their favourite story on Wednesday 15th January . Additionally, please can each child bring in at least one kitchen roll tube or a small, empty plastic bottle for an exciting art project that we will be completing on Thursday 16th January to launch our new 'Talk 4 Writing' unit.		
Science	In science, the children will be learning about 'Plants'. This week, they will focus on understanding the parts of a flowering plant and its functions.		
Integrated Curriculum	In topic, the children will be discussing significant national changes. This will involve comparing pictures of the UAE from the past to the present day.
