Year 5 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 13th January 2025

Maths	Next week in maths, the children will be continuing their learning of decimal numbers. They will be ordering and comparing them and continuing to add and subtract them.
English	The children will be collaborating to create a success criteria for writing a set of instructions. They will then have a practical lesson where they are tasked to put something together. Once they have done this, they will be writing their own set of instructions to explain the process they took to complete the task.
Science	Next week, the children will plan and participate in a fair test to find out which surfaces have the most amount of friction and which surfaces have the least. They will then be learning about water resistance and buoyancy and will design a boat that can move and float on water.
Integrated Curriculum	The children have loved our first week of lessons! Next week, we will be looking at mountains. We will be learning how mountains are formed and the features of them.
