Year 1 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 20th January

This week, we will continue with our Meerkat Mail text during our Talk 4 Writing lessons. We will revisit the text daily and will use our own actions to it to help us remember the text. Then we will sequence events in the story and act out our favourite part. We will end the week by adding our own ideas to create a different version of events.

In maths, we will complete our place value work and focus on teen numbers. We shall understand how these are represented in numerals and words. As well as understanding each numbers value and different ways this can be shown.

In phonics, we will learn the digraphs igh (Yellow I) as in light, or as in for and ore as in sore. We will identify, read and write words using these sounds, as well as challenging ourselves to write simple sentences.

In Science, we will recap our learning about animals and the groups they belong to such as mammals, reptiles, birds, insects, fish and amphibians. We will then learn about herbivores, carnivores or omnivores and explore some of the animals that have each of these diets.
