### Dear Parents,



# Year 2 learning:

#### Week beginning: Monday 20th January 2025

Maths	In maths, the children will learn about subtraction. They will start the week by subtracting one 2-digit number from another (not across a ten). For example: 23 - 12 = 11. The children will subtract from the ones first, 3 - 2 = 1, and then subtract from the tens, 20 - 10 = 10. They will also use visual representations, such as dienes, to support and deepen their understanding. Following this, the children will learn strategies for subtracting one 2-digit number from another (across a 10), which will involve the extra step of 'exchanging'.
English	In English, the children will learn about traditional tales. This half term, we will be focusing on the story of 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. The children will start each lesson by 'talking the text' before discussing and clarifying the meaning of different vocabulary from the story. They will then recap their knowledge of adjectives, including how to use them to make their writing more varied and interesting, before using and applying their understanding of different punctuation.
Science	In science, the children will continue to learn about the unit 'Plants'. This week, there will be a focus on describing the life cycle of a plant.
Integrated Curriculum	In topic, the children will be discussing significant national changes. They will work in groups to debate the advantages and disadvantages of the changes made to: schools, jobs, transport and homes over time.
