# Year 4 learning:

### Week beginning: Monday 20th January 2025

Maths	The children will be investigating the links between multiplication and division. The will be recapping their learning on 2-digit multiplication by 1-digit multiplication as well as their times table knowledge.
English	Following on from their work on scene descriptions, the children will be learning how to write stage directions for a playscript. They will be learning in depth about adverbs and using some drama to look to see what it would look like on stage
Science	The children will be writing up their experiment that they performed last week. They will then be starting to learn about the water cycle. They will be making a small representation of what the water cycle looks with a sandwich bag and dyed water.
Integrated Curriculum	The children will be learning about different types of Greek Art such as mosaics. We will be showing the children the Greek Alphabet which they will be able to include in their artwork.
