Year 5 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 20th January 2025

Maths	Next week, the children will be deepening their understanding of decimals. They will then be learning how to find equivalent fractions. After this, they will be comparing and ordering fractions less than 1 and then compare and order fractions greater than 1.
English	Next week, the children will be looking at text structures to understand the purpose and audience for a piece of writing. They will be learning how to use parentheses and will be planning to write a survival guide.
Science	In science next week the children will be continuing their learning of water resistance and buoyancy. They will be creating their own boat to test on water, considering which shape will work best. After this, the children will be introduced to air resistance and will be testing how to make one piece of paper fall faster than the other.
Integrated Curriculum	Year 5 are going on their trip next week! They will be taking part in a survey of the area and creating a piece of art that captures the mountain. Then, the children will be learning how to use four-figure grid references.
