Year 6 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 20th January 2025

Maths	This week, we will continue exploring measurements by focusing on perimeter and polygons. We will learn how to calculate perimeters and examine the connection between area and perimeter.
English	Writing - This week we will be identifying direct and reported speech, identifying and using synonyms to replace 'said' and creating complex sentences using a subordinate clause.
Science	In Science this week we will be exploring how shadows are formed. We will look at the angle of light and how it affects shadow lengths. In the lab, they will apply their knowledge and understanding accordingly by testing angles of light and measure shadows.
Integrated Curriculum	In Integrated Curriculum we completed our electronic presentations. We now put all our focus on starting our Formula Ethara topic. This week we will be looking at the importance of picking the correct team members and also identify the expectations for this topic.
