Year 1 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 27th January

This week, we will continue with our Meerkat Mail text during our Talk 4 Writing lessons. We will revisit the text daily and will use our own actions to it to help us remember the text. We will then use our own ideas to change some of the text and create our own versions. We will plan our ideas first then put these into sentences. We will also complete a recount of our visit to the zoo following our class trip.

In maths, we will complete our place value work and focus on numbers to 50. We will order the number and understand how these are represented in numerals, words and mathematical objects such as cubes and diennes. As well as understanding each numbers value and different ways this can be shown.

In phonics, we will learn the digraphs au as in August, aw as in draw and complete a recap on the sounds we know so far. We will identify, read and write words using these sounds, as well as challenging ourselves to write simple sentences.

In Science, we will recap our learning about herbivores, carnivores or omnivores and explore some of the animals that have each of these diets. We will then use this knowledge to sort animals into groups based on their diet.

Please also be reminded that the **Mid-Term Break** will begin at **12pm** on **Friday 7th February** School will resume after the break on **Monday 17th February**.


Week beginning: 3rd March 2025
