### Year 2 learning:

#### Week beginning: Monday 27th January 2025

Maths	In maths, the children will consolidate their knowledge of addition and subtraction. Following this, we will begin the new unit 'Statistics'. The children will start by making tally charts before exploring tables and graphs, such as block diagrams and simple tables. They will end the week by learning all about pictograms before collecting data and presenting the data in their own pictogram.
English	In English, the children will continue to 'talk the text' of 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. The children will begin the week by discussing their opinions about 'Jack and the Beanstalk', such as parts they like/dislike and any questions they have. Next, they will use their knowledge of adjectives and apply it to the characters from the story. Following this, the children will use the previous day's learning to write a character description for Jack or the giant. They will end the week by practising to write some of the sentences from the story, which will be dictated to them by a partner.
Science	In science, the children will continue to learn about 'Plants'. This week, there will be a focus on how seeds are dispersed. The children will then investigate different types of seed dispersal, such as: wind, water, 'catching a lift' and being eaten by humans and animals.
Integrated Curriculum	In Integrated Curriculum, the children will look at aerial photographs of UAE landmarks. Then, they will research forts from around the UAE and discuss their characteristics.


#### Week beginning: 3rd March 2025
