Year 3 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 27th January 2025

Maths	This week the children will be learning how to tell the time. Firstly to o'clock and then half past. The children will be practically using clocks to make times. Then moving on to quarter past and quarter to the hour. Later in the week the children will learn past the hour, and then to the hour and will understand how many minutes are in an hour, and how many hours are in a day.
English	The children will be continuing the innovate stage (writing our own story). Firstly learning how to plan a paragraph at a time, and then writing it up focusing on using speech punctuation where needed.
Science	Continuing on our learning journey about fossils, the children will be learning about Mary Anning (fossil collector and paleontologist). We will be exploring who she was and what she did. Later on in the week, we will be briefly touching on soil formation and the process soil goes through.
Integrated Curriculum	We will be continuing our Stone Age topic, with a deeper focus on the Neolithic Era and how the people lived during this time. The children will understand how things changed throughout the 3 eras, and how hunting changed to farming. Design and Technology - we will be finishing off our DT unit by evaluating our Stone Age pouches.
